I will make a long story short.

In 2004, the graduate School of Kuroshio Science was established in Kochi University. Actually I belonged to the graduate school at that time.

One of the research subjects of the graduate school was related to the conservation of marine environment along the Kuroshio current.

In 2005, the next year after the establishment of the graduate school, some members of the graduate school including me visited the Philippines and met Professor Bradecina in Bicol. He kindly explained marine protected areas in the Philippines for us

This is the origin of the collaboration between Kochi University and Partino State University.
